UCSD Supervised Clinical Hour Requirement:

1. Student eligible, by resume, to take the IBCLC exam by pathway A,B,E OR A+G+H, OR B+G+H
UCSD requires 150 supervised clinical hours
2. Pathway F: Student *is not eligible* to take IBCLC exam by pathway A, B or E or A+G+H, or B+G+H
UCSD requires 300 supervised clinical hours.

Basic 6 subjects: (All RN's, LVN's, and RD have met the basic 6 requirement)

Anatomy and Physiology, Sociology **OR** Cultural Diversity, Psychology, Counseling **OR** Communication Skills, Child Growth and Development, Nutrition, Medical Terminology

All UC San Diego students who successfully complete the UC San Diego lactation consultant training program are eligible to sit for the IBLCE exam and are expected to sit for the IBLCE exam for certification.

UCSD students have to do minimum of 150 or 300 hours of clinical time inside/during the UCSD training program. To know how many hours of clinical, please determine your level of education and then how many hours of working with moms and babies. The past experience can be any time in your past.

You have one of the following:

1. BS/BA, or 120 semester hours of college, or more
 - a. Documented **1500+ hours** of clinical experience in your past working with moms and babies breastfeeding
UCSD requirement: 150 clinical hours inside of program
 - b. Documented **less than 1500 hours** of clinical experience in your past working with moms and babies breastfeeding
UCSD requirement: 300 clinical hours inside of program
2. AS/AA/ADN, or 60 semester hours of college:
 - a. Documented **3000+ hours** of clinical experience in your past working with moms and babies breastfeeding
UCSD requirement: 150 clinical hours inside of program
 - b. Documented **less than 3000 hours** of clinical experience in your past working with moms and babies breastfeeding
UCSD requirement: 300 clinical hours inside of program
3. Less than 60 semester hours of college credit or no college credit:
 - a. Documented **5000+ hours** of clinical experience in your past working with moms and babies breastfeeding
UCSD requirement: 150 clinical hours inside of program
 - b. Documented **less than 5000 hours** of clinical experience in your past working with moms and babies breastfeeding
UCSD requirement: 300 clinical hours inside of program
